




Welcome to Duluth!

hen the TAP Board of Directors approved the location for this year's TAP Dance, I was very excited. But for someone who enjoys sailing, anything adjacent to water is exciting. While I probably won't find the time to charter a boat, just being within view of Lake Superior will be satisfying.

I trained on San Francisco Bay on a multitude of old fiberglass sailboats (what we weekend sailors call "classic plastic"). My first day out on the bay was a very humbling experience for myself and my sailing school classmates. While we thought we had done everything necessary to prepare, a stiff wind and a fast flood current seemed to have materialized from nowhere and the results spoke for themselves: boat meets concrete pier, concrete pier meets mast, mast meets water. Timidity on our first day out had gotten the best of us as we had forgotten the first rule of sailing: a sailboat is most maneuverable when going fast.

After a few drinks in the marina watering hole, we all agreed our first "sea story" needed some embellishment – dark, stormy weather was added, heavy seas with 10 foot tides, and I think by the last round of drinks a whale or unidentifiable sea monster was thrown in for good measure. We also agreed preparedness was an important tool when sailing, along with a healthy respect for water.

Conditions can change quickly in the travel industry too; delays, cancellations, health concerns, terrorism, weather, etc. can conspire and confound. Being prepared may make all the difference, which is why trade shows like TAP Dance are so important. Our Preferred Professional Travel Providers (PPTPs)

are lifelines for tour operators, providing essential information to prepare for what lies ahead of a group at a destination. Likewise, tour operators provide insight into how PPTPs can better prepare their businesses and destinations for the lucrative group market. Without this symbiotic relationship, strengthened by the free exchange of information, the group travel industry is neither prepared nor sustainable.

And sharing information is what TAP Dance is all about: PPTPs and tour operators working to prepare for the future through conversation, networking, and brainstorming. These are the key terms to remember this week. While you may enter a meeting with preconceptions, you may also emerge with new business. Working together around a table, like my fellow sailing schools students, may produce a new unique idea or itinerary – maybe on the same level as a whale or fantastical sea monster.


